Counties Affected

- Cecil County, Maryland
- Harford County, Maryland

Both are designated rural jurisdictions by the State of Maryland. Combined population: 358,326 (Cecil County 102,885; Harford County 255,441). Combined land area: 945 square miles. Both counties lie in Maryland's northeast corner, along the Interstate 95 corridor between Baltimore, Maryland and Wilmington, Delaware.

Municipalities and Service Sites

- Elkton, Cecil County, Maryland — Cecil Community Recovery Center, 227 Howard Street, Elkton, Maryland 21921.
- Aberdeen, Harford County, Maryland — Harford Community Recovery Center, 7 Aberdeen Shopping Plaza, Aberdeen, Maryland 21001. This center relocates to Edgewood, Harford County, Maryland during 2026.
- Elkton, Cecil County, Maryland — three certified recovery residences operated by Voices of Hope, Inc.

Services are also delivered by project staff in community settings throughout both counties, including accompanying participants to treatment, primary care, and behavioral health appointments. No peer is placed in any hospital or clinical facility under this project.

Priority Funding Areas

All service sites lie within certified Priority Funding Areas. Elkton and Aberdeen are incorporated municipalities, which are Priority Funding Areas by statute under Maryland law. The Edgewood relocation site lies within the certified Priority Funding Area along the Route 40 corridor in Harford County.

Construction and Land Use

No construction, renovation, demolition, land acquisition, or ground disturbance of any kind is proposed under this project. No building will be altered. This project funds the delivery of peer recovery support services by existing staff at existing, leased facilities.
